Communal Area—there has been work to improve the drainage and the grass has been cut. The next stage of the grant from the Big Lottery Fund has to be submitted by spring next year. The funding allows for a professional agricultural architect to be taken on to manage the project who will take over obtaining quotes, organising when the work is done etc. Bryan Ugalde is still supervising the overall work.

Methodist Chapel—after 3 planning applications and various objections, Cornwall Council has approved the conversion of the Chapel to a 4 bedroomed house. Concerns still exist about the access from the A390.
